What is an MD, DO, PA, and NP?



MD (Doctor of Medicine)

It is a medical degree awarded to individuals who have completed medical school and undergone rigorous training to become licensed physicians. MDs are trained in the art and science of medicine, enabling them to diagnose and treat a wide range of medical conditions, perform surgeries, and provide comprehensive healthcare to patients.

DO (Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine)

DOs are licensed physicians who have completed medical school with additional training in osteopathic principles. They emphasize a whole-person approach to patient care, considering the interplay of the body's systems and the role of the musculoskeletal system in health and disease. DOs also sometimes use osteopathic manipulative treatment (OMT) to diagnose and treat certain medical conditions.

PA (Physician Assistant)

PAs are healthcare professionals who work under the supervision of physicians. They are trained to provide medical care and services to patients, including diagnosing and treating illnesses, ordering and interpreting diagnostic tests, and prescribing medications. PAs play a critical role in the healthcare team, contributing to primary care and specialized medical practices.

NP (Nurse Practitioner)

NPs are advanced practice registered nurses with specialized education and training. They have the authority to diagnose and treat medical conditions, prescribe medications, and provide a broad range of healthcare services. NPs often specialize in various areas of medicine, such as family practice, pediatrics, women's health, and mental health.

Vegetarian Cauliflower Mac

Servings 4-6

Ingredients

3 tbsp. olive oil, plus more for baking dish 1 lb. fusilli bucati 1 medium-sized head cauliflower, cored and

Prep Time 20 min

Cooking Time **15 min**

chopped 3 cups spinach 4 cloves garlic, diced 1 large yellow onion, thinly sliced Kosher salt and freshly Ground black pepper 4 oz. Italian cheese blend (asiago, mozzarella, romano, fontina) 2 oz. Parmesan cheese 1/4 tsp. mustard powder Pinch cayenne pepper

Directions

STEP 1 Preheat the oven to 425°F & lightly oil a 9-by-13-inch baking dish.

STEP 2 Cook desired pasta according to package directions. Drain the pasta and reserve 1 cup of water.

STEP 3 Heat 2 tablespoons oil in a large pot over medium heat. Add cauliflower, garlic, and onion. Season with salt and pepper. Cook, covered, stirring occasionally, until tender, set aside and let cool. **STEP 4** Combine the vegetables, mustard powder, and cayenne in a blender and purée.

STEP 5 Add in reserved pasta water to get desired texture and blend until smooth

STEP 6 Add sauce, Italian cheese blend, parmesan, and spinach to pasta and toss to combine. Transfer to prepared baking dish. If desired, sprinkle additional cheese over the pasta. Bake until golden brown, 14 to 16 minutes.

Instant Pot **Butternut** Squash Soup

Servings 6-8

Ingredients

2 cups vegetable stock 4 cloves garlic, minced 1 Granny Smith apple, diced 1 medium (uncooked) butternut squash, peeled, seeded, and diced

Prep Time **12 min**

Cooking Time **30 min**

1 carrot, peeled and diced 1 sprig of fresh sage 1 white onion, diced 1 peeled potato, diced 1/2 teaspoon salt, or more to taste 1/8 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

Calories 124 kcal

1/8 teaspoon ginger
Pinch of ground cinnamon and nutmeg
1/2 cup canned
(unsweetened) coconut milk
Optional garnishes: extra coconut milk and a sprinkle of smoked paprika

Directions

STEP 1 Add vegetable stock, garlic, carrot, apple, butternut squash, sage, onion, potato, salt, pepper, ginger, cinnamon, and nutmeg to an Instant Pot pressure cooker. Toss to combine. Close lid securely and set vent to "Sealing".

STEP 2 Press "Manual", then press "Pressure" until the light on "High Pressure" lights up, then adjust the +/- buttons until time reads 8 minutes. Cook. Then very carefully, turn the vent to "Venting" for quick release, and wait until all the steam has released and the valve has dropped. Remove the lid. **STEP 3** Remove and discard the sage. Stir in the coconut milk.

STEP 4 Use an immersion blender to puree the soup until smooth. (Or you can transfer the soup in two batches into a traditional blender, and puree until smooth, being very careful when working with the hot liquid.) Taste, and season with additional salt, pepper, and ginger if needed.

STEP 5 Serve warm, with optional garnishes if desired.
